Consequences for tourist offering

Mechelen follows federal government regulations to contain the spread of the Corona virus.

Until at least Friday April 3rd, monuments, museums, attractions, cafés and restaurants will be closed and all public events postponed or cancelled in a bid to combat the spread of the Corona virus COVID-19.

- The **Tourist Information Office** and **UiT in Mechelen** will close until at least 03/04. We will continue to be contactable by email, telephone and social media during our opening times.
- Museums and attractions will close until at least 03/04. For specific information about a particular location, please refer to the relevant organization.
- Cafés and restaurants will be closed until at least 03/04, with the exception of certain takeaway restaurants.
- All **shops** providing essential services, such as food shops, animal food shops and pharmacies, will remain open, including at weekends. Other shops will close at the weekends.
- **Events** have been cancelled until at least 03/04. For specific information about a particular event, please refer to the relevant organization.
- Some **hotels** are closed, other will remain open until further notice; hotel restaurants will close. Check their websites for up-to-date information.
- With the exception of St Rumbold's Cathedral, the Basilica of Our Lady of Hanswijk and the Church
 of Our Lady of Leliëndaal, the historical churches will close.
- City parks and gardens will remain open.
