



IF WALLS COULD TALK

This listening walk takes you back in time to the Mechelen of 1473. With a wooden ear trumpet you can listen to conversations between nobles, workers, beguines, prisoners and other people from the 15th century. Your guide is the medieval architect Antoon I Keldermans. He takes on the role of storyteller and will lead you through Mechelen for 1.5 hours.

HOW DO YOU START THE WALK?

-  Follow the route on the map with your ear trumpet.
-  Every number on the map indicates a stopping place, marked on site with a sticker.
-  Place your ear trumpet against your ear and press the start button to listen to the conversation.

- People who are **blind** or **partially sighted** can feel the buildings in a special brochure that can be borrowed.
- People who are **hard of hearing** can connect the audio guide via their smartphone.
- People who are **deaf** can follow the walk in Flemish sign language, with or without subtitles. Also appropriate for people with **mental challenges**.


After this walk, why not visit the St Rumbold's Tower and Museum Hof van Busleyden, where you can learn all about the Burgundian Renaissance.
